




DRY CLEANING

<p>STEP 1</p> <p>Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (coveralls, personal protective eye wear, boots and gloves)</p> 	<p>STEP 2</p> <p>Starting on top deck, scrape and brush the sidewalls, division gates and floor of the trailer</p> 	<p>STEP 3</p> <p>Scrape/brush the tail lift of the trailer</p> 	<p>STEP 4</p> <p>Remove any deposits of mud, straw etc. from wheels, wheel arches, mudguards and exposed chassis</p>



DISINFECTION

<p>STEP 1</p> <p>Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (coveralls, personal protective eye wear, boots and gloves)</p> 	<p>STEP 2</p>  <p>Outside, start at top and work down with attention to wheels, arches, mudguards and underside of vehicle</p>	<p>STEP 3</p> <p>Inside, starting on top deck and working down, disinfect ceiling, sidewalls, divisions, floors and the tailgate</p> 	<p>STEP 4</p> <p>Disinfect all vehicle equipment, tools and the belly box</p>

DETERGENT WASH & HIGH PRESSURE RINSE

<p>STEP 1</p> <p>Soak all external surfaces with heavy-duty cleaner solution</p> 	<p>STEP 2</p>  <p>Clean the outside from top down, with attention to wheels, arches and mudguards</p>	<p>STEP 3</p> <p>Inside, soak the ceiling, sidewalls, division gates and floor of top and bottom decks</p> 	<p>STEP 4</p> <p>Wash the tail lift and gates thoroughly</p> 
<p>STEP 5</p> <p>Wash all vehicle equipment, tools and the belly box</p> 	<p>STEP 6</p> <p>Leave detergent solution for at least 20 minutes in order to penetrate and lift caked on dirt</p> 	<p>STEP 7</p> <p>Rinse all surfaces and equipment at high pressure with clean water</p> 	<p>STEP 8</p> <p>Inspect all internal and external surfaces to ensure they are thoroughly clean</p> 

CAB DISINFECTION AND FINAL STEPS

<p>STEP 1</p> <p>Remove mats and brush debris & organic matter into a refuse sack for disposal</p> 	<p>STEP 2</p> <p>Wash the cab floor, mats and vehicle pedals</p> 	<p>STEP 3</p> <p>Using a clean cloth soaked in disinfectant solution, disinfect cab floor, mats and floor pedals</p> 	<p>STEP 4</p> <p>Park vehicle on a slope to drain and dry</p> 
<p>STEP 5</p> <p>Once the vehicle has been removed, wash away any remaining debris from the area</p> 	<p>STEP 6</p> <p>Disinfect overalls and boots</p> 	<p>⚠ Use an appropriate Department of Agriculture Food and the Marine registered disinfectant DAFM list of registered disinfectants for use against certain exotic diseases</p>
